2. *Use Times New Roman for English (font size 12), Kalpurush for Bengali (type using Avro) and Mangal Unicode-compliant font for Hindi and Sanskrit (font size 12 for all), with 1.5 line spacing. The title should be concise and clear, headings in font size 14 (bold), subheadings in size 12 (bold) and main body text in size 12 (regular).*
3. *Each paper must begin with an abstract not exceeding 300 words, including 5-6 keywords that reflect the key themes of the paper.*
4. *The total word count of the manuscript must not exceed 5000 words, excluding references, tables and figures.*
5. *Graphical representations, diagrams, charts and other visual aids may be included if necessary, and should be appropriately labelled and referenced in the text.*
6. *Author(s) must adhere strictly to the APA 7th Edition referencing style for both in-text citations and the reference list.*
7. *The manuscript should be submitted only in Microsoft Word format.*
8. *The full names of all contributing authors must be included, along with their current designations, affiliated institutions, email addresses and ORCID.*
9. *The article must be plagiarism free (Below 10%).*
10. *The paper should follow the tentative structure outlined below:*
  - a. Abstract
  - b. Keywords
  - c. Introduction
  - d. Review of Related Literature
  - e. Objective of the Study
  - f. Hypothesis/Research Questions
  - g. Methodology of the Study
  - h. Result & Discussion
  - i. Conclusion
  - j. References
